## Introduction to Textile Collage Supply List

Project Size: Your choice up to 20"

- 1 yd SF101 Pellon fusible interfacing
- 1/2yd. Steam-a-Seam **II-Lite** (fusible on **both** sides) OR 1 package (5 sheets)
- backing fabric for finishing. This will be discussed and examples of different ways of finishing will be shown.
- \* Selection of 1/4yd or fat quarters: 100% cotton quilting fabrics, scraps.

  Backing fabric. Select fabrics you love and include light, medium and dark tones, favorite colors, and a range to choose from. Beginners should start with a limited palette of 3-4 colors. Solid colors and/or prints. I often use conversation fabrics for added fun and stripes, spots, dots, circles, geometric/graphic for added pizzaz.
- \* Other fabric selections acceptable if you are more experienced with handling difficult fabrics.
- \* If you have a selection of fabric scraps to share, please do.
- \* Fabric scissors
- \* Pins
- \* Optional: glue stick or Aleene's tacky glue, rotary cutter, ruler and mat and thin batting for finishing on your own (to be shown and discussed)
