This is my selection of brushes, bring the brushes that you have as long as you have a variety of sizes and styles.

Brushes and Tools

- A variety of Flat brushes
- A variety of Round brushes
- A variety of Filbert brushes
- A Fan Brush
- A Long Rigger Brush
- 1" color shaper
- Chip Brushes 1/2", 1" (Micheal's)
- Foam Brushes 1/2" (Micheal's)
- · Palette Knife, trowel type

Mark Making tools

- Black ink bottle with dropper
- Pitt pastel, black
- 6B Pencil
- Acrylic Ink, black (small bottle with eye dropper)
- Extra Soft Vine Charcoal
- Eraser
- Sharpenter
- A Cheap Combs (Dollar Tree)

Substrates

- Synthetic Multimedia paper 9 x12
- Synthetic Multimedia paper 5 x 7
- 1 Canvas 9"x12"
- 1 Cradled Wood Panel 12"x16"-7/8" deep

Acrylic Paint

PAINT COLORS and medium (DO NOT BUY student grade, basic, standard, or level 1 paint. These are lower quality, low pigment, that is why they are less expensive. Keep these for your grand-children!) These colors below are the basic to have in your paint box. Get the Professional quality paint.

- Phthalo blue/green Shade (Cool blue)
- Ultramarine Blue (Warm blue)
- Alizarin Crimson (warm) or Quinacridone Magenta (cool)
- Luminous Opera (cool) (Acrylic Holbein)
- Indian Yellow (Warm yellow)
- Yellow Light or Hansa or Primary (Cool yellow)
- Black (Mars or Carbon black)
- A larger tube of Titanium white
- Satin Glazing Liquid medium
- Matte Medium

Heavy body or fluid are OK or a mixture of both. However, I prefer fluid. Bring what you have!

ALSO additional items:

- Palette paper (16x12)
- Smooth Viva paper towel
- Spray bottle
- Small bucket for water
- Masking Tape HERE

• A piece of cardboard 12X16" (backing of pads or pizza box are great, not the corrugated ones)

Pre workshop assignment: With masking tape, mount one 9x12 Synthetic Multimedia paper on a 12"X16"



card board. Press on the tape firmly to prevent bleeding paint. Then, with masking tape, divide the sheet in four rectangles. See attached image.
