





SUPPLIES

Paper

Watercolor paper. 140lb. (300 g/m2). Or any thick and textured paper with highly absorbs characteristics. Wine is a liquid material and needs to be absorbed by paper.



Wine

Any kind of red wine. Nice to a Cabernet or strong wine, to get intensive pigment.

Red wine - Pink shade Cabernet/ Strong wine - Violet shade




Pallet

Small containers to add some wine and to make different concentrations to get multishades
